

## STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

<b>ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)</b>		<b>£1871.00</b>
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event, or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.		
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements.		£898.00
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care.		£125.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased will rest at our service rooms of Gibson of Tayport only.		£150.00
Providing a suitable coffin – Wood effect veneer, fully lined and furnished to a high quality.		£348.00
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director.		£100.00
At a date/time, you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse driven by professional chauffeur.		£250.00
<b>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</b>		
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event, or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.		
Burial (funeral director's charges only).		£545
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee). <sup>2</sup>		£1044
<b>FEES YOU MUST PAY</b>		
For an Attended or Unattended burial, the <b>burial fee</b> . <sup>1</sup>		£753.00
For an Attended cremation, the <b>cremation fee</b> . <sup>2</sup>		£675 - £1070
Please discuss any <b>specific religious, belief-based and/or cultural requirements</b> that you have with the funeral director.		

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

<sup>2</sup> In England, Wales, and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
